TriArts seeks to enroll all students wishing to participate in its summer programs, regardless of ability to pay. Therefore, several different forms of financial assistance are available:

- 1) TriArts offers scholarship assistance (up to 25% of tuition), based on financial need. Please see attached application form.
- 2) The Michael Busch Scholarship Fund for Youth at TriArts will award 1 - 2 partial or full scholarships annually, based upon talent and financial need. Please see attached essay form.
- 3) TriArts offers additional financial assistance, based upon need, through a Volunteer/Credit Program. Please see attached information.

Volunteer/Tuition Credit Program

In an effort to increase the amount of financial assistance opportunities and to increase our volunteer base, TriArts has a Volunteer/Tuition Credit Program. This program allows parents and students a way to convert volunteer hours into credit for tuition for TriArts Youth Theatre Programs.

The rate is as follows: for every hour of volunteer work, a student will be awarded a \$15 credit applicable towards tuition for a Youth Theatre Program. More than one family member may earn credits (including students age 14 and over) of up to half the tuition cost through this program. The number of participants will be limited each season, and will be selected based upon the attached Financial Assistance application, prior volunteer experience, and interest areas listed below.

TriArts needs many volunteers each season, especially to help with: sewing, dressing during performances, parking, painting, carpentry, and working backstage.
